The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing respondents No. 4 and 5, who are brother and mother of petitioner No. 1, not to interfere in the personal life of the petitioners.

It has been averred in the petition that the petitioners are major and the date of birth of petitioner No.1-Jyoti is 10.10.1989 and the matriculation certificate has been appended as Annexure P-1 in support thereof. Petitioner No. 2- Amit Kumar is stated to have been born on 28.4.1990 as per the secondary school examination certificate appended as Annexure P-2. It is further alleged that the petitioners got married on 11.4.2016 in a Mandir at Jind as per the Hindu rites against the wishes of respondents No. 4 and 5 and the marriage is an inter caste marriage. The photographs of the marriage have been appended as Annexure P-3 with the petition.

The petitioners had made a representation dated 14.4.2016 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No. 2 regarding their grievance and resultantly, they have approached this Court.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the veracity of the age and validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law in view of the law laid down in Lata Singh vs. State of UP, AIR 2006 SC 2522, if required.

The petition stands disposed of.
