JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought quashing/setting aside FIR No.47, dated 15.03.2014, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 19, Chandigarh (Annexure P-10) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Harjinder Singh, Economic Offences Wing, Chandigarh that on conclusion the investigation, untraceable report has already been prepared, which is likely to be presented shortly in the court of Jurisdictional Magistrate.

In view of the preparation of the untraceable report, instant petition has rendered infructuous and it stands disposed of accordingly.

Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh is directed to ensure the presentation of untraceable report in the court of Jurisdictional Magistrate within a period of one month from the date of a certified copy of this order positively.

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However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court again.
