Draws attention of this Court to the memo dated January 22, 1998 being a letter from the Director of Secondary Education, Haryana, Chandigarh, addressed to the Advocate General, Haryana, Chandigarh, informing that the claim of the petitioners for award of JST grade on acquiring higher qualification B.A./Inter/TDC-I, has been granted. In view of various pronouncements of the High Court and the Supreme Court handed down in the matter of the higher scale, necessary sanction has been accorded restricting the arrears to 38 months prior to the filing of the writ petition and further with the condition that required qualification should have been acquired prior to March 9, 1990 and appointments in Government service were made prior to the same date. This renders the petition infructuous as relief has been granted to the petitioners.
