The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing respondents No. 4 to 7 not to interfere in the personal life of the petitioners.

It is further alleged that the petitioners are major and the date of birth of petitioner No.1-Amandeep Kaur is 7.9.1991 and the matriculation certificate has been appended as Annexure P-1 in support thereof. Petitioner No. 2- Devinder Singh is stated to have born on 15.9.1990 and the photocopy of the voter card has been attached as Annexure P-2 in support thereof. It is further alleged that the petitioners got married on 13.4.2016 as per Sikh Rites at Gurudwara Guru Nanak Niwas Sahib, village Karor Kalan, Tehsil Kharar, District Mohali against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 7. The photographs of the marriage have been appended as Annexure P-3 with the petition.

The petitioners had made a representation dated 13.4.2016 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No. 2 regarding their grievance and resultantly, they have approached this Court.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the veracity of the age and validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law in view of the law laid down in Lata Singh vs. State of UP, AIR 2006 SC 2522, if required.

The petition stands disposed of.
