Counsel having argued that matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.23 dated 15.03.2016, under Sections 420/406 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Counsel makes an additional submission that the petitioner would be ready and willing to surrender and if thereafter an application for bail is filed, directions are prayed that such application be decided forthwith.

As per prayer made by counsel, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is clarified that in case the petitioner surrenders before the Investigating Agency/Illaq Magistrate within a period of five days from today and thereafter, files an application for bail, the same would be decided strictly on merits and the Court would make an endeavour to expedite the disposal of the same.
