The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 05.06.2015 having been arrested in another FIR which has been registered on the basis of secret information that the petitioner is habitual of smuggling and was lodged in Ferozpur jail and has established links with Pakistani smugglers with the help of other co-accused. On the basis of recovery effected from non-petitioners Bhupinder Singh, Sohan Singh and Rajinder Singh, the petitioner has been involved in the present case. It is also alleged against the petitioner that he had been giving instructions for supply of heroin while in custody.

No recovery having been effected from the petitioner, he can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court in FIR No.11 dated 15.06.2015, under Sections 21/25/29 of the NDPS Act.

Nothing said in this order will effect the merits of the cases pending against the petitioner.
