By filing the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought quashing of the FIR No.17 dated 15.02.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324 and 34-IPC and later on Section 326-IPC at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur, on the basis of compromise/affidavit (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

On 23.04.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the parties have compromised the matter. The case is still under investigation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.P.S. Gill, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Reply be filed before the next date of hearing.

List on 5.8.2016.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate, which shall record the statements of the parties and report back to this Court whether the compromise is genuine or without any pressure.”

Neither in pursuance of the order dated 23.04.2016, parties appeared before the learned Illaqa Magistrate nor the learned counsel for the petitioners has caused representation. It appears that the parties have lost interest in the matter.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed at this stage.
