Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Pritam Singh alleging that on 02.06.2014, the complainant and his brother were attacked by the petitioner and four others armed with weapons like 'daang' 'kirpan' and base ball bat.

Co-accused of the petitioner Lakhi Singh allegedly fired from his 12 bore double barrel gun resulting in pallet injuries on the left eye of the complainant. So far as the petitioner is concerned, he has not been attributed any specific injury.

An application for quashing of FIR on the basis of the compromise had been dismissed in view of the nature of the injuries attributed to co-accused of the petitioner.

The petitioner, though, was armed with 'kirpan' but having not been attributed any specific injury, he can be granted concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
