By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.42, dated 22.03.2016, registered under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Division No.2, Jalandhar.

It is contended that the complainant is brother of deceased, Ashok Kumar and even if the allegations raised by the complainant are taken to be correct at their face value, no offence for abetment of suicide under Section 107/306 IPC would be made out.

He further states that in pursuance of the order dated 23.04.2016, the

petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.04.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
