JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Pintu in case FIR No.273 dated 20.06.2015, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 452, 436, 307, 341, 332, 353, 427, 109, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Khaidki Daula, District Gurgaon (**Annexure P-1**).

On 20.06.2015, due to receipt of a electric shock by co-worker Pawan Kumar, he was removed to the hospital. The said news triggered of unrest amongst the fellow workers in the factory premises. The workers are alleged to have damaged the vehicles, furniture and even tried to put fire to a room where the management officials were hiding. The prosecution has identified and challaned 35 accused workers.

The role attributed to the petitioner is that of damaging the vehicles and also an attempt to put a room on fire.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 23.06.2015 and the case is at the initial stage of recording of 37 cited prosecution witnesses.

The petitioner is also stated to be not involved in any other case.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Gajraj Singh, is unable to refute the custody period, non-involvement of the petitioner in any other case and the stage of the trial.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the role attributed to the petitioner, custody period, non-involvement of the petitioner in any other case and the fact that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
