Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 8 however states that respondent No.5, the mother of petitioner No.1 would like to meet the

petitioner No.1. It is not disputed that the parties stay in District Yamunanagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioner No.1 would have no objection in meeting respondent No.5 in the Court of the Sessions Judge, Yamunanagar.

Learned Deputy Advocate General and learned counsel for U.T. as well as learned counsel for respondent No.5 have no objection to this course of action.

In the circumstances, the petitioners are directed to appear in the Court of the Sessions Judge, Yamunanagar on 12.08.2016 and the Sessions Judge is directed to permit the respondent No.5 to meet the petitioner No.1 over there.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Secondary Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 25.11.1997 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Secondary Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 12.10.1990. They have also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Yamunanagar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
