This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.10 dated 20.1.2016 under sections 326, 324, 34 I.P.C registered at Police Station, Bahavwala, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

F.I.R came to be registered on the complaint of Sher Singh in relation to an occurrence that took place on 20.1.2016.

During the course of arguments it has gone uncontroverted that the complainant/injured has suffered two injuries on his forehead with a sharp edged weapon and both these injuries are attributed to Sohan Lal i.e. father of the present petitioner.

In so far as the present petitioner is concerned, the role attributed is of having landed fist blows on Banwari Lal i.e. father of the complainant.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 1.3.2016.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C i.e. CRM No. M-16566 of 2016 has been filed in this Court for

quashing of the F.I.R in question on the basis of a compromise having been effected and in which notice of motion already stands issued for 8.8.2016.

Even otherwise, investigation in the present case is complete and even challan stands presented.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Fazilka.

Petition disposed of.
