This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for
grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0380 dated

Panipat City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 02.05.2016 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Ram Mehar has accepted this fact and stated that the petitioner is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 02.05.2016 is made absolute. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
