Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to provide adequate security and other arrangements for peacefully conducting the annual election for the 5 Member Committee of Mansa Truck Operators Union, District Mansa and for directing respondent No.2 to appoint Local Commissioner to act as an observer of the elections.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 i.e. Deputy Commissioner, Mansa to consider the representation dated 5.4.2016 (Annexure P-5) made on behalf of the

petitioners.
