The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.27 dated 25.02.2016 registered under Sections 379-B, 511 & 34 IPC at Police Station Division No.3, District Jalandhar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner is aged about 20 years. The FIR shows that the petitioner, as a pillion rider on motorcycle owned by him, had tried to snatch a purse but without successes. On the contrary, the motorcycle skidded and fell down but the petitioner was successful in running away.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the offence is serious but it is stated that there is no other case against the petitioner. She further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner shall not involve in any criminal activity.

In that view of the matter interim order dated 22.04.2016 is made absolute. The above said undertaking of the petitioner be made part of the police file.

Disposed of accordingly.
