HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 and 2 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and not to interfere in his peaceful life.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no case registered against the petitioner, but still the police is calling the petitioner. He further states that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has approached respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon and has made a representation dated 18.4.20-16 (Annexure P-3), but no action thereon has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take note of the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
