Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and their family member at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representations were moved to respondents No.2 to 4 but till date no action has been taken. He further contends that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to dispose of the said representations within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation (Annexure P-2) dated April

11, 2016 and in case some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
