ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This revision has been preferred by the husband aggrieved by the order of interim maintenance, passed against him.

An application has been filed seeking maintenance under the Domestic Violence Act by way of interim arrangement considering the income of the husband. The trial Magistrate had allowed Rs.1,500/- per month to be paid as maintenance. A revision was preferred by the husband which has been dismissed on 05.08.2015. Both the Courts below had noted that the petitioner was doing agricultural work. The wife has no independent source of income. The husband had admitted that he had an income of Rs.8,000/- per month. The allegations made by the wife was that he had income of more than Rs.30,000/- per month. The petitioner had failed to place on record the document to show the land owned by him. That material was kept away from the Court. In the light of the above, I find no merit in the petition.

The petition is dismissed in limine.
