Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of interim bail to the petitioner-Amarjeet in case FIR No.184 dated 18.7.2012 for offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 353, 307, 302, 199 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Manesar, Gurgaon.

Prayer for interim bail is made for undertaking examination for Bachelor of Arts.

Upon notice learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Devinder Kumar submits that only three papers are alleged to be undertaken by the petitioner-accused and two out of the said three exams already stands conducted on 21.04.2016 and 26.4.2016. The third exam is scheduled to be

held on 28.04.2016. He thus submits that the petitioner has approached this Court at a belated stage and as such is not entitled to grant of interim bail.

It is next contended that the petitioner is one of the principal accused in the aforesaid FIR and the trial is at the fag end.

Keeping in view the belated stage and the fact that the trial is at the fag end, no case for grant of interim bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
