By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.34, dated 06.03.2014, registered under Sections 302, 482, 120-B, 148 read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur.

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 25.04.2016, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and have furnished bail/surety bonds.

The learned State counsel does not dispute the above

fact.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 25.04.2016, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
