DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.53 dated 17.06.2015 registered under Sections 306/34 IPC at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case, whereas, no offence is made out against him as neither any connecting evidence has come on record during investigation nor any abetment is there. Co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Daljeet Singh, Baljit Singh @ Jeet and Jaspal Singh have been released on regular bail and the petitioner is in custody since 17.06.2015.

No purpose would be served, in case, the petitioner is kept behind the bars.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has not disputed the custody period as well as release of co-accused of the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and by considering the fact that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Daljeet Singh, Baljit Singh @ Jeet and Jaspal Singh have already been released on regular bail, the petitioner is in custody since 17.06.2015 and also that no purpose would be served, in case, he is kept behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Kulwinder Singh is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
