This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect his live and liberty as well as his family members and to initiate departmental proceedings against respondent No.4.

2. Notice of motion to the respondents.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Arjinder Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that representation dated 18.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved to Senior

Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar (Punjab) but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 18.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
