Quashing of FIR No. 94 dated 05.03.2013 under Sections 406/498-A/354-A IPC and Section 67 of the I.T Act, registered at Police Station Sector 39, U.T. Chandigarh, is being sought on the basis of compromise deed dated 27.07.2015 and 23.09.2015 (Annexure P-2 and P-3).

Respondent No. 2 got married to petitioner on 18.10.1999. Due to temperamental differences, both the parties could not live together as husband and wife. Out of the said wedlock, two children were born. The relationship between them became strain and thereafter, the F.I.R was registered against the petitioner on account of bringing less dowry and harassment caused by the petitioners.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised, vide

compromise deed dated 27.07.2015 and 23.09.2015 (Annexure P-2 and P-3).

In compliance of order dated 22.07.2016, report of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh, has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been recorded. Complainant stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioner. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the statement given by the petitioner.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 94 dated 05.03.2013 under Sections 406/498-A/354-A IPC and Section 67 of the I.T Act, registered at Police Station Sector 39, U.T. Chandigarh, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of.
