The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.60 dated 10.05.2015 under Sections 326/307/34 IPC registered at Police Station, Division No.2 Ludhiana at the instance of respondent No.2-Gurbhej Singh alleging that on 06.05.2015, the complainant was attacked when he intervened in a dispute between the petitioners and his parents. Petitioner No.1 allegedly gave a dang below hitting the right arm of the complainant. Petitioner No.2 is attributed to have given a kirch below on the left side of the abdomen of the complainant.

The FIR having been registered under Section 307 IPC, I do not deem it appropriate to permit quashing on the basis of compromise. However, it will be open to the witnesses to depose the truth on oath before the trial Court.

The petition is dismissed. However, the circumstance of compromise may be taken as a mitigating circumstance by the trial Court to grant any benefit to the accused during the trial.
