ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is the second petition filed on behalf of the petitioner who is the mother in law of the deceased seeking regular bail in FIR No.114 dated 30.11.2015, registered under Sections 304-B IPC, Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Ropar. The first petition was withdrawn in February, 2016.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that this was the second marriage of the deceased and the husband is in custody and investigation is over and challan has been presented and charge has been framed and the statement of the complainant has been recorded. It was urged that the

deceased was earlier married and there was no divorce decree. It was urged that the deceased had strangled her daughter and then ended her life by consuming poison. It was urged that the petitioner is in custody since 08.12.2015.

The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
