Report dated 19.07.2016 sent by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division)-Cum-JMIC Malout has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Jagsir Sharma @ Sonu as well as of complainant Gagandeep it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.72 dated 03.10.2014 under Sections 295-A IPC and Section 66(1) of Information Technology Act, 2000, Police Station,

Kabarwal, District Muktsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
