JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Anita Rani-petitioner, seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 for protecting her life and liberty, at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Arjinder Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner is major and her date of birth is January 01, 1993. She has

passed graduation. With her free-will and volition, she is living with one Badal son of Krishan Pal at village Kumbran, Sector 68 Mohali since the last week of March 2016 but respondents No. 4 and 5 are extending threats to her life and liberty, which necessitated the filing of instant petition.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 01.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if he comes to the conclusion that there is a threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner, to provide her necessary security in accordance with law, immediately, on receipt of certified copy of this order.
