This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that allegations in the FIR are totally vague. Same has been registered as counter blast to FIR No. 33 dated 12.3.2013 (Annexure P/2). He submits that same deserves to be quashed.

Heard.

Instant FIR was registered on secret information. The investigating agency was informed that one Surinder Singh was present at the railway station. He had number of mobiles running on various sim cards issued on fake addresses. Same could be recovered in case raid was conducted. Pursuant to FIR investigation ensued. Counsel for the petitioner submits that investigation has been completed and challan has been filed.

In view of nature of allegations contained in the FIR, there is no ground for quashing the same. The plea raised by the petitioner can be appreciated only after evidence is led before the trial court.
