FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

It is inter alia argued by the learned counsel for the petitioner that from the illegal possession of the petitioner Gurdit Singh @ Geetu on 25.11.2015, 31.2 grams of Alprazolam, an intoxicant of non-commercial quantity was recovered and that the petitioner is in custody since 25.11.2015 and has undergone more than 09 months of incarceration which is conceded to at bar by the learned State counsel.

In view thereof and keeping in view that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed.

Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
