TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.08 dated 24.01.2016, under Sections 326/323/324/148/149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that offence under Section 326 IPC which has been added subsequently is on account of an injury allegedly suffered by Simarjit Singh @ Simar on his head in an occurrence that took place on 16.01.2016 and which has been specifically attributed to the present petitioner.

In view of the serious allegations of having caused a grievous injury and that too on a vital part of the body of the injured,

this court does not find any infirmity in the order dated 28.03.2016 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Amritsar declining concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Petition dismissed.
