The instant petition has been filed under Section 439(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') for cancellation of regular bail granted to the private respondents in FIR No.18 dated 02.03.2013, registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station Mahila, District Bathinda.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The instant petition is premature. As per the compromise reached between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the petitioner was to approach the respondents after obtaining the passport for her facilitation to move abroad and join the company of her
