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**JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)**

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought indulgence of this Court for registration of FIR against the culprits for the offences under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 506 IPC and for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

2. In response to the issuance of notice of motion, reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Gurmail singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police Shahbad, District Kurukshetra on behalf of official respondent(s) has been filed.

3. A glance at the aforesaid reply transpires that an enquiry was conducted into the allegations unfolded in the complaint and on conclusion of

the said enquiry, report was marked by Superintendent of Police to Legal Advisor of the Office Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra. He has also submitted his opinion on 31.07.2013 that from the perusal of the enquiry report and other documents, no forgery or embezzlement of trust money or breach of trust have been found to be committed and further that dispute in between the parties is of civil nature. Accordingly, it was consigned vide report dated 11.08.2013.

4. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the inquiry report, instant petition has rendered infructuous and it stands disposed of accordingly. However, the petitioner is at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available to him under the law.
