JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Varinder Pal Singh in case FIR No.114 dated 23.11.2015 for offences punishable under Section 61 of Excise Act registered with Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

It is contended that FIR has been lodged on a secret information and the alleged recovery of 240 bottles contained in 20 boxes of country made liquor "Mota Santra" has been planted on the petitioner. It is further contended that there is no recovery effected even as per the FIR and, therefore, a totally false case has been foisted.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the

interim directions passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by HC Harbhajan Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 07th of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
