Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed this petition for protection.

Learned counsel for the State has produced copies of statements of both the petitioners, which are taken on record.

As per statements suffered by the petitioners, they do not want any police protection, as there is no threat to their life and liberty from the other side.

In view of the categorical statements made by both the petitioners, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the concerned SSP, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
