The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.24 dated 20.04.2011 registered under Sections 323, 325 and 34 IPC at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

In the above said FIR there are three accused persons out of which only two has preferred this petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and complainant as well states that there is compromise by Jaspal Singh and Mangal Singh with the complainant. There is no compromise qua third accused namely Gopi.

Pursuant to order passed by this court verification statement has been recorded and report has been received by this court under letter dated 18.05.2016 along with statements of the complainant and the petitioners. I have seen the same.

In view of the above I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-13841 OF 2016 is allowed in terms of the prayer clause in the petition.
- (ii) The complaint FIR No.24 dated 20.04.2011 registered under Sections 323, 325 and 34 IPC at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala, is quashed and set aside along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners Jaspal Singh and Mangal Singh only.
