Petitioners along with two others had allegedly waylaid complainants Hardeep Singh and Talwinder Singh by intercepting their car. Petitioner No. 1 had allegedly fired shot causing injuries in the legs of the complainants and petitioner No. 2 has been attributed *lalkara*. The incident is of July, 2012.

On asking of the Court, it has been informed that the co-accused of the petitioners have been acquitted.

On the instructions of ASI Rajinder Singh, it has been informed that the supplementary challan has not been presented against the petitioners.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case.

There are serious allegations against the petitioners of having fired shots on the complainants about four years back. It will not be appropriate for this Court to quash the FIR or the proceedings on the basis of compromise.

Dismissed.

However, this order will not in any manner prejudice the right of the petitioners to seek acquittal on the basis of the statements made by the complainants in the Court during the trial.
