This is an application for placing on record the relevant pages from the passport of the petitioner.

Application is allowed and the documents are taken on record.

CRM-M-13856-2016

This petition has been filed for challenging the order dated 15.07.2014 whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender in FIR No. 113 dated 02.10.2011 registered under Sections 13/17/25 (54) of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 and Arms Act, 1959, 120-B IPC at P.S. Maqsudan, District Jalandhar.

The precise grievance is that the petitioner has not come back to India since October 2010 and he has placed on record copy of his passport.

Learned DAG has gone through the documents and on instructions from ASI Paramjeet Singh has accepted this fact.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has not returned to India since 2010.

In these circumstances, the order declaring him proclaimed offender is set-aside and petitioner may be granted 03 months time to come back in India and join the trial.

In the circumstances, in case the petitioner appears and comes back to India and surrender before the Trial Court on or before 20.12.2016, Court will release him on bail and thereafter proceed further with the case.
