The petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.25 dated 06.02.2016, registered under Sections 382, 384, 342, 506, 120-B and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana City.

Heard.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely roped in the instant case on account of his enmity with the complainant.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the instant petition. On instructions, she states that in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court, the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner did not join the investigation in terms of the orders passed by this Court, no case for grant of relief sought is made out.
