Prayer made in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to comply with the provision of Section 160 Cr.P.C. read with Section 41 Cr.P.C. and to give at least 7 days advance notice to the petitioners in writing in case they are required in connection with any enquiry, investigation in a criminal case and further not to harass and call them to the police station without any reasonable cause.

Learned counsel for the State has filed reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, by way of affidavit of Anil Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Ferozepur along with statement of Petitioner No.1-Anrej Singh(Annexure R-1) as well as statement of petitioner No.4-Hardeep Singh(Annexure R-2). Same are taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Maninder Singh and on the strength of the said reply, submits that so far as petitioner Nos. 1 and 4 are concerned, they do not require any protection, as there is

no apprehension from the other side and to that effect they have submitted their respective statements as Annexures R-1 and R-2 respectively. He further submits that as on date, the petitioners are not required in any case.

In view of the aforesaid developments, present petition stands disposed of, as petitioners have no surviving cause of action.
