The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 28 dated 4.3.2015 registered under Section 376-D,452,386,506 and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual offences Act, 2012 at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot.
