The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.96, dated 21.10.2015, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506,
148, 149, 326 of the IPC, at Police Station Ghoman, District Gurdaspur.

On 26.4.2016, the following contentions were noticed :-

“ Petitioner along with other members of
unlawful assembly had allegedly assaulted Jagdeep
Singh complainant. So far as the petitioner is
concerned, he has been attributed 'lalkara' only. All
the injuries have been attributed to his co-accused
Jobanjit Singh and others, who were allegedly
instigated by the petitioner.”

Learned Addl. AG Punjab has accepted that the allegation against the petitioner is only 'lalkara'.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, this petition is allowed and the order dated 26.4.2016 is made absolute subject to the compliance of provisions of Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
