For having been found in possession of 480 grams of intoxicating powder containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride, the petitioner has been in custody with effect from 27.01.2015. The representation submitted by the petitioner before the Administrative Judge during the course of jail inspection has been treated as bail petition. The petitioner has submitted the application without informing that he had earlier withdrawn two applications for regular bail before this Court through the counsel.

Taking into consideration the said circumstances and commercial quantity of intoxicating powder having been recovered from the petitioner, no ground is made out to grant concession of bail to the petitioner. The petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, a direction is issued to the trial Court to make earnest endeavour to dispose of the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of six months after the receipt of copy of this order.
