Reply on behalf of State by way of an affidavit of Satpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran has been filed in the Court today. Same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that on 5.3.2016 as a consequence of FIR No.12 of even date a case under Section 21 of NDPS, Act was registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran against the petitioner in respect of recovery of 50 grams of heroine on which date the petitioner was arrested and due intimation to his father Swinder Singh was given and, thereafter, on 6.3.2016 the petitioner was produced before the concerned Court. It is further reiterated that the petitioner is habitual offender as even, prior to this, another FIR bearing No.111 dated 14.9.2012 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act has been registered at police station Sarhali against the petitioner and the matter is at the stage of trial before the learned

Special Judge, Tarn Taran.

In the light of the stand of the State there has been due legal recourse against the petitioner and, thus, nothing survives in the present petition, the same, as such, stands dismissed.
