On the instructions of ASI Kewal Krishan, it has been informed that the petitioner has joined investigation.

On asking of the Court, as to what could be the reason for implication of the petitioner in the case, counsel for the petitioner submits that as a matter of fact, the petitioner had intervened in a money dispute between Ajay and the complainant. On account of petitioner having supported Ajay, the complainant has fabricated the story.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, at this stage, it is sufficient to observe that the petitioner has joined investigation and it does not appear to be a case of custodial interrogation. The petitioner appears to have a probable good defence as submitted by counsel for the petitioner.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the condition that he will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.
