Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise. Assistance of the state counsel was sought on the last date of hearing. He points out that petitioner is a proclaimed offender. Five other accused are already facing trial. Allegation against the petitioner is that he fired shot towards the house of the complainant.

Under the circumstances, no case for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise is made out. Counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas before the trial court at the appropriate stage.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
