Petitioners have filed this petition seeking protection of their life and liberty as they have married against the wishes of their parents.

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that statements of both the petitioners and respondent No.4 have been recorded. According to State counsel, there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners at present. Counsel for respondent No.4 submits that petitioner No.1 is minor and her marriage with petitioner No.2 would be void. This court does not intend to express any opinion on the validity or otherwise of the marriage.

Petition is disposed of in view of the fact that statements of the concerned parties have already been recorded.
