Main case

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 directing respondents No. 5 to 13 not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by lodging false complaint.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of

the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though representation/complaint dated 21.03.2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 21.03.2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
