This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of Execution Petition No.34/2015 dated 20.10.2015 as well as impugned order dated 28.01.2016, whereby, the conditional warrants have been issued against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the order of maintenance, the appeal was filed but the same has not been heard and conditional warrants have been issued against the petitioner. Learned counsel also submits that till the appeal is heard, the conditional warrants may be stayed.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner and have also perused the documents available on the file.

Admittedly, the appeal has been filed against the order for

grant of maintenance under Section 125 Cr.P.C., which is still pending. The petitioner is having remedy to approach before the Appellate Court. Without availing any remedy before the Appellate Court, the present petition has been filed before this Court.

No ground is made out to interfere with the order.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
