JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Gopal Krishan Gupta-petitioner seeking issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 20.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) filed by him.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. *Inter alia* learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though respondent No. 4 is the real son of the petitioner but he is

humiliating and harassing the petitioner on one pretext or the other and has made his life miserable. He further contends that though a complaint/representation dated 20.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) has been moved to the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 20.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
