The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in FIR No.304 dated 08.10.2014, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The petitioner is in custody since 08.10.2014. The petitioner had never misused the concession of interim bail granted to him.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that as per the report of the chemical examiner, allegedly recovered intoxicated powder contained the salt 'Nitrazepam' and being 520 grams same is a commercial quantity.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the quantity in question is commercial in nature, no case is made out for bail at this stage.

Dismissed.
